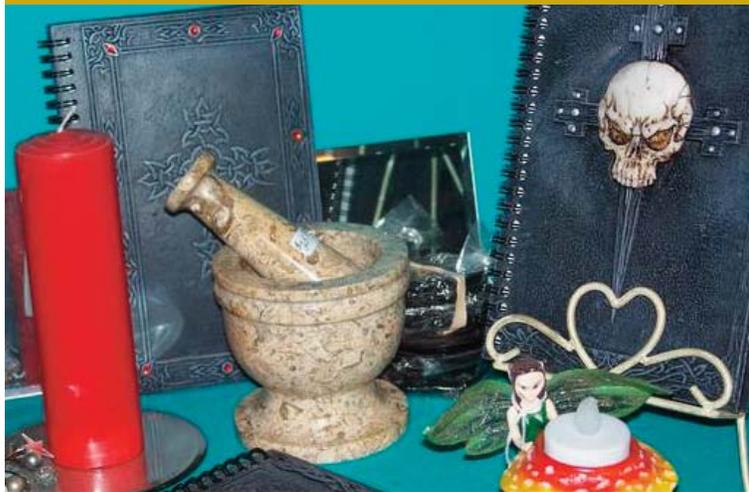




Waynesboro After Dark Ghost Tour

Saturday, August 22nd



Arrive at 6:00 p.m. to take time to peruse **Kindred Spirits Aroma & More** at 226 East Main Street. This funky little shop offers candles, herbs, journals, fairies, dragons and tons more cool stuff!

Meet up with everyone at 7:00 p.m. at **Little Rocky's New York Pizza** at 5 East Main Street for dinner.

There will be two different tours being presented consecutively with 15 attendees in each tour at 8:30 p.m. **There is a 30 person limit on our evening, so make sure you sign up early!**

WEST MAIN STREET TOUR

About 15 stops, covering a distance of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile.

Begins and ends at historic Oller House, **138 West Main Street.**

We will explore the history of Waynesboro as well as specific West Main buildings and occupants.

We will examine spelunking beneath the streets of Waynesboro, the destructive stable fire of 1892 and German folklore, local legends, and numerous local haunts that remain with us on the West end of town.

EAST MAIN STREET TOUR

Approximately 15 stops, covering a distance of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile.

Begins and ends at Adventures in Coffee, **230 East Main Street.**

We will explore our earliest history of Waynesboro, and discuss Indian attacks, toll roads, stories of South Mountain and Jack's Mountain, 15 days of rebel occupation, sprawling industry, old fashioned trolleys, and as always, the haunts that remain with us on the East end of town.

Dinner is pay-on-your-own.
