Dannion Brinkley Headlines A Day of Inspirational Speakers - July 27 in Lancaster, PA *(Kelly will be attending)*

Dannion Brinkley, New York Times best-selling author of *Saved By The Light*, will be appearing at Lancaster Host Resort and Conference Center in Lancaster PA on July 27th headlining a day of inspirational speakers hosted by Your Inner Light. Dannion will speak from 2 to 6pm about his three life-altering, near-death experiences and the profound revelations he received. Having been to the other side he brings a unique perspective on Life and Death as we know it.

In addition to being the author of *Saved By The Light*, *At Peace In The Light*, and *The Secrets Of The Light*, Dannion Brinkley has been a hospice volunteer for 34 years and has spent more than 30,000 hours at the bedside of dying veterans. In 1997 he co-founded the Twilight Brigade, a California-based non-profit that raises awareness about the needs of the dying, especially veterans, as well as the benefits of standardized end-of-life care. Comprising approximately 5,000 bedside volunteers, the Twilight Brigade acts as an independent entity within hospice facilities and veteran's hospitals across the country, supporting the terminally ill and their family members through professional education, community outreach and advocacy.

Other presenters at this event include Reverend Sylvia Seward, executive director of Radiant Light Healing Center in Reading, PA, who will lead the opening ceremony at 10am and speakers Iryne Carrasquillo (medium and healer) and Martine Bloquiaux (intuitive, author and healer). Iryne connects to the other side and offers a pathway for those of us here to touch where Dannion has been, and Martine helps with the Journey on this plane, ensuring long and productive existence in which we accomplish all we came for, resulting in a smooth transition to the other side.

Carlisle Barracks Ghosts... and a UFO - The witness in a case assigned to me by MUFON (light with anomalous movements in sky north of Carlisle seen in late June) is an Army vet now employed as a civilian on post there. He has not only seen two apparitions (a small girl and what appeared to be a soldier from the 18th century) but has also witnessed a strange UFO on the post about 15 years ago. The UFO he believes was some sort of 'scout' craft, basketball sized sphere with a bold black hourglass design on its metallic silver surface. He also had some strange experiences visiting the Little Big Horn Battlefield (where an ancestor died with Custers 7th Cavalry). - JDW



Inside the Spangler Barn A tangible sense of agony even I was able to detect here... taken during a 7/3/14 NPS battle walk on a stormy night that transitioned to sunset... this followed mortally wounded Genl Armisted's route from Cemetery Ridge/High Water Mark to the George Spangler Farm 11th Corps Hospital - the last journey many would take on July 3, 1863. Walking in the footsteps of these brave souls never fails to move me! Nearly 2000 casualties (mostly Union, but some CSA, such as Armisted) were treated here. The Elliot map shows close to 200 dead were buried nearby, most removed and reburied in the National Cemetery, but the energies of their suffering clearly remain at this beautiful - and haunting site. - JDW
