There are several ways one looks at the paranormal field. You have your people who are firmly against it, nothing short of Big foot attacking them in the woods, their house being crushed by a UFO or the Library scene in Ghostbusters would convince them that something paranormal exists. Although, if they saw that it would bring up the question of is it paranormal or just normal but that is a question for another time. Then you have true skeptics, ones who believe the paranormal field is possible, but prove it to us. Personally, a friend who is a true skeptic and looks at the field with true open eyes I say is one of the greatest friend and gifts one in the field can have. It keeps us true and grounded. However, watch out for those whom call themselves skeptical but actually are not... talk about headaches they give you. Then you have believers - it just makes sense. We begin picking up from a spirit. The name that comes through on the radar she knows. It is the name of her father-in-law. She asks several questions only he would know. We get answers in agreement. We come to the agreement it is her father in law. I ask her if she wants to go get her husband on this major development. She answers yes. When they arrive downstairs I tell her you should inform him of what we have encountered. She proceeds to tell him take a seat - this is a major one. We are talking to your father. The man says ok. How do I handle stuff I come into? How do I handle the gift I am given? And to put blunt with it hitting so close to home I was scared.

At around 7 a couple slip out of my hand and hit the floor. Put them back in and do a three card spread for myself. Draw death, oh it's a symbolic I figure. Been having some problems with a relationship I was in. Later, that night I am sitting in the back room during the investigation. Now we know it was a grow house when it was a fraternity. But, this night I am getting the feeling something heavier. I know it is cocaine. No historical evidence but I know it. Getting burning nose. And the feeling some died of it. Fast forward to two days later. While bowling and my mom calls me and tells me, "your nephew Tony Miles has died of a cocaine overdose." I did not realize it at the time but I knew it. The Smurl's claims gained wide press attention and were investigated by demonologists who encouraged the Smurl's supernatural beliefs, and clergy, psychologists, and scientific skeptics who offered more parsimonious explanations.
